

Upon arrival at Camp every camper must deposit their cash into Camp Bank. Money spent at tuck shop will be automatically deducted from your Camp Bank. The only time campers will need to take out cash is when we are going out for the day and you require some spending money. Cash can be paid back in when we get back. At the end of camp any remaining funds will be returned to you.

If you require travel medication please ensure you take it before we leave and bring supplies for the week.
